<u>Lesson Plan</u>

Argentine Geography/Social studies overview

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Grade Level: Elementary School

<u>Focus:</u> Introduce Argentina to the class, show the principal landscapes, folk instruments, traditions, Spanish words, music, and folk dances of the country.

Materials: Wifi, smartboard or projector, computer, audio.

Ohio Music Standards:

2PR Follow and respond to the cues of a conductor.

5PR Sing, move and respond to music from world cultures and different composers.

Objectives:

- Students will have an approach to Argentine culture, music, and dance.
- Students will experience, respond to, and perform an Argentine song with corresponding movements.

Activities/Teaching Sequence:

- Show a map of the American continent and ask students to point where the United States is located. Then, point where Argentina is located.
- Ask the students to share with you some words that they know in Spanish.
- Show a video of the most beautiful argentine landscapes:

 https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=PeIHQN2z5Wk and ask the following questions to discuss geographical characteristics of the country: Do we have similar landscapes in the US? Have you ever been to places similar to these ones? What animals did you see in the video? Which landscapes did you see? Do you think that Argentina is a big country?
- Show the students this map to put the two countries in comparison https://www.mylifeelsewhere.com/country-size-comparison/united-states/argentina
- Teach the students to sing the verse "Manuelita Donde vas" a refrain from a popular children's song from Argentina: "Manuelita" by Maria Elena Walsh
- Then, show the children a video of the story of Manuelita, and invite the students to sing the refrain with you.

Translation:

Manuelita (the turtle) lived in Pehuajo but one day she left to Paris, she went and no one knew just how a little bit by roaming and a little bit by walking

Manuelita, Manuelita,

Manuelita Where are you? with your shell of malachite and your step so bold

• Teach the following motions and Dance with the song

clap in place 8 beats,
walk 4 beats starting towards the right forward and n the shape of a rhombus,
circle 4 beats,
claps 8 beats,
stomping in the place,
claps 8 beats,
stomping in the place,
back and forward in 4 beats
circle in 4 beats.
and then, repeats.
